Ladies & Gentlemen:

At the December meeting of the Association I volunteered to head a committee to develop Long Range Plans for maintenance of our community's infrastructure and to deal with the issue of Shoreline Erosion. The resolution adopted by the Association in response to my suggestion authorized a temporary committee with a deadline of June, 2007 to accomplish its mission and deliver a final report. That report is enclosed.

It has become evident to the members of the committee that (1) six months is not enough time to develop comprehensive long term plans, and (2) it will require a permanent organization to achieve their implementation. For those reasons, we recommend that the Association make Long Range Planning a permanent committee and appoint its members to multi-year terms. All of the members of the Ad Hoc committee have expressed their willingness to serve on such a permanent committee.

I take full responsibility for the Ad Hoc Committee's failure to accomplish the goals defined in its enabling resolution. All of the members have made important contributions and we believe we can jointly formulate long term plans and oversee their implementation if we are given enough time to do so.

Long Range Planning is an absolute requirement for Arundel on the Bay. Please do not interpret our inability to complete the tasks we were given as an indication that they are not important or achievable.
